



## Austin E. Kurtz

February 12, 1930 - April 5, 2017

Austin Edward Kurtz formally of Johnstown, PA died peacefully on April 5, 2017 at the age of 87 at the Southwestern Veterans Center in Pittsburgh, PA. Austin (Auz) was born on February 12, 1930, and preceded in death by his wife, Sue (Conrad) Kurtz and his parents, Sophie (Brendel) and Joseph Kurtz.
