On Saturday, December 10th, Carmen "Bunky" Sousa, loving father of two and grandfather of four, passed away at the age of eighty-four. Born to Carmen and Jane (Titora) and brother of Theodore, Carmen lived his entire life in the Pittsburgh area residing in Larimer, Morningside, Allison Park, and in Gibsonia at the time of his passing. Carmen was an active member of International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 66, devoting more than 66-years of service to that organization. Carmen also served his country as a Medical Supply Specialist in the Army being honorably discharged in July 1961.

Carmen was best known for his quick-witted humor and ornery spirit as he loved giving everyone a hard time. He is survived by his two children, Karen Reyher (husband John) and Jeffrey (wife Julie), and four grandchildren, Adam Reyher (wife Megan), LT Corey Sousa USN, Rachel Reyher and Christian Sousa.
