Edmund Henry Sigmund was born on November 7, 1959 in McKees Rocks, PA. Ed unexpectedly passed away on March 1, 2017. Ed graduated from Sto-Rox Senior High School. After High School he graduated from Rosedale Technical Institute with a Degree in Automotive Technology. Ed was talented in mechanical and industrial arts. During his high school years in Industrial Arts class and beyond, he made some fine crafted wood furniture pieces, which remain in the family. Additionally, friends, family, and school teachers continued to seek Ed out for his automotive and mechanical skills during and after his school years.

Ed's skills transferred well to the Video Gaming era. Many friends and family may recall Ed's great gaming skills exhibited by playing hours on one quarter on games such as "Pac-Man" and pinball machines. He hung out with his school age friends in Stowe Township/West Park on Broadway Avenue and "Direnzo's" Italian corner market.

In the late 1980s early 1990s Ed changed his occupational interests and was employed with the "Original Oyster House" a Historical Landmark located in Market Square district in Downtown Pittsburgh, PA. Ed quickly excelled and

advanced from delivery driver for all Original Oyster House Greater Pittsburgh locations. Owners and managers recognized his work ethic and skills. He helped hone his work ethic spending his summers with his brothers at the Chartiers Country Club caddying, etc. while most kids were outside playing. The Oyster House management fast tracked him to cook, bartender, supervisor, manager, and within 2-3 years he rose to general manager of several of the restaurants locations in Downtown Pittsburgh, Oakland, Gibsonia, and Monroeville, PA.

After the Oyster House closed all but their Downtown location, he finished his employment with them in that location. Ed returned to his skill-set roots and was employed in various home improvement stores, and he was a General Contractor until his recent death.

We would be remiss if we didn't acknowledge Ed's servant heart and sacrifices in regards to his Mother. Ed helped and took care of her for a decade. As her health declined in her last years of life he was still there as a primary caretaker.
