We were very lucky to have had her for as long as we did, we learned a lot from her.

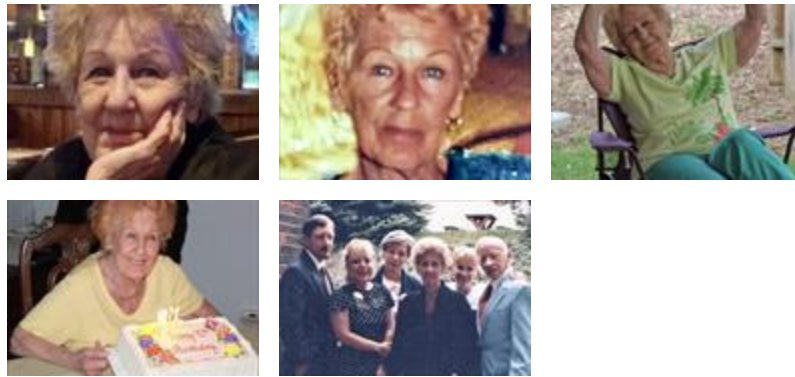
We all love her and will miss her very, very much.
