The world became a little less bright on May 28, 2025 when Lawrence "Larry" Wittig, 73, passed away after a long battle with Alzheimer's Disease, his loving wife, Sharon, by his side.

Born June 16, 1951 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late George and Evelyn (Tobin) Wittig. Devoted father to Terra (Michael) Wertz, Shauna (Joshua) Bennett, Corey (Carrie) Wittig, and Kaitlyn (Yigit) Wittig Menguc, a loving husband of 46 years to Sharon (Warner), and a soulful guide to many. Larry's legacy is one of love, courage, spirituality, reflection, reading, writing, selflessness, family, and peace-keeping. Never without an encouraging word, Larry was a poetic soul with an open mind and a quick wit to match.

He is survived by his wife, four children, six grandchildren, brothers, Robert (Mary Ann) and Gregory (Niki) as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers George, James, Daniel, and sister, Margaret.

Larry served in the U.S. Air Force (1969-1973) as a security police sergeant

stationed in Michigan, Korea (Kunsan/ Osan), and Maine. His work history included warehouse supervisor, painting contractor, "Mr. Mom," and online shop owner, curating unique books and rare art.
