A sister of St. Francis of the Neumann Communities (Millvale Franciscans), died on December 19, 2025 at The Province of Wexford. She was predeceased by her parents, William Ufheil and Clara (Bayer) Ufheil. She is survived by many cousins and relatives. Penny Hoak, a cousin, was a frequent visitor to Sister Margaret Ann.

Sister Margaret Ann was baptized at St. Anthony Church, Millvale, grew up in Millvale and attended the preparatory high school for the Sisters of St. Francis. She entered the Community in 1955 and went on to receive degrees from Mt. Mercy (Carlow) and Duquesne (MS in Education 1973). Sister Margaret Ann took many academic and enrichment courses, and was certified as a Spiritual Director in 2007.

In her years of ministry, Sister Margaret Ann was a middle school teacher, principal at St. Joseph, Mt. Oliver (1980-1985), Parish Minister St. John Fisher, Churchill, and Pastoral associate (Guardian Angels).

At Mt. Alvernia, beginning in 2006, she was part of the local coordinator team

for the Sisters. For many years following, she offered spiritual direction to people who came to Mt. Alvernia or The Province of Wexford.

Sister Margaret Ann's journey included special travels, including a trip to St. Croix to see Sister Barbara Woody, and a trip/retreat to Assisi with Sister Donna Stephenson.

In all of her ministries, she radiated the light of Christ to those she met. In the almost 7 years since she became a resident at The Province (formerly The Waters) of Wexford, she has shared this light with staff, residents and her Sisters, Franciscan Associates, as well as friends and family who came to visit. Her smile, light, and gratitude graced all by her presence. As we prepare to welcome Jesus, the Light of the World, at Christmas, we know that she will continue to be a light to all those who love her.

Heartfelt thanks are given to Bethany Hospice, who cared so compassionately for Sister Margaret Ann, and to the nursing staff at The Province, who were so caring and solicitous for her needs.
