She passed away quietly on Monday, July 6, at Family Hospice Ctr in Pgh surrounded by close friends. Born in Erie, PA, she graduated Academy HS, received her BS in Nursing from Carlow Univ and was a nurse at The Children's Institute and the Falk School. She had been retired. Beth was a longtime proponent of reproductive and women's rights and worked on early Lesbian and Gay Pride demonstrations. Her activism dates to the "good times at Shawn's Bar," said a friend. She is survived by her father Ronald, her siblings Carol Kaiser (David) and Tim (AnneMarie) of Erie and Greg of Las Vegas and her nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her mother MaryAnn.
