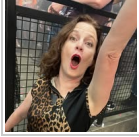

I was just getting to know her when this terrible thing happened. I think of her so often.

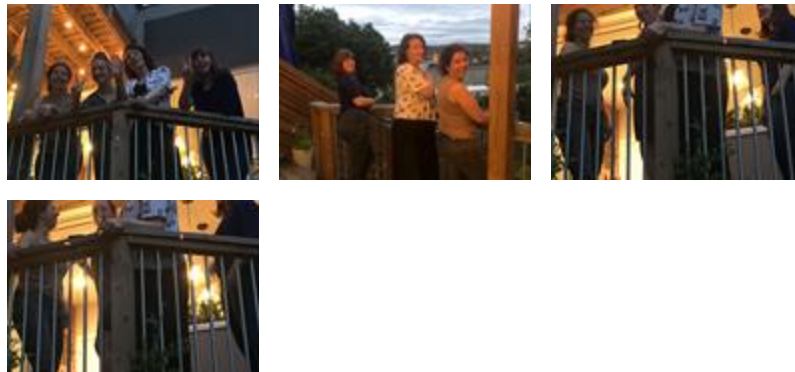

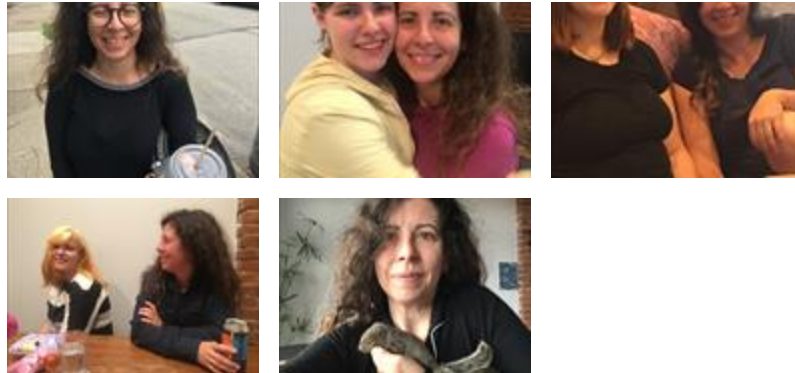
