Sidney S. Pollack, 85, of Kingsbridge, Bronx, Squirrel Hill and Highland Park, left peacefully on Wednesday, August 12, 2015. Sid Vicious, as he was known nowhere but on the tennis court, is deeply mourned by his beloved longtime friend and companion, Lois Jackson, his sister Ruth Brooks of Queens, NY, his children, David (Avery Schneider-Pollack), Linda Bugosh (Don Bugosh) and Aaron (Rosalba Piazza), and grandchildren Elsbeth, Mollie, and Samantha Pollack and Alex and Ryan Niemocienski, and expanding circles of family and good friends too numerous to mention.
