Practiced law for fourteen years in New York City, for many years in Pittsburgh with the United States Steel Corporation and Aristech Chemical Corporation, in Houston with Westlake Chemical Corporation, and as of counsel to Thorp, Reed & Armstrong in Pittsburgh. Active in charitable and political affairs in New York City, including organization of Amsterdam Community Center (now Lincoln Square Neighborhood Center), a settlement house. Loved to travel with his wife and their friends. Organized family

vacations that were as memorable as he hoped they would be. Grew to enjoy the sporting events to which his sons dragged him. Avid reader. Justified admirer of his own grilling skills. Decided at age sixty that he needed to get in shape, and kept it going for more than thirty years. He was an amazing husband and father.
