Toye Lynne Starver, age 57, passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh, PA. She was born on January 28, 1961 in Pittsburgh to Donald LeRoi and Shirley Anne (Randolph) Starver. She was a graduate of Pittsburgh Academy High School and attended college at the Art Institute of Pittsburgh.
